



Memorandum of Understanding B-4937/Un.20/HM.01/09/2024 between

UIN Raden Mas Said Surakarta

and

Centre for Research in Early Childhood

Universitas Islam Negeri Raden Mas Said Surakarta and Centre for Research in Early Childhood (CREC), United Kingdom, are mutually interested in cooperation in education, research, and cultural exchange. To the extent feasible, both parties will develop programs and activities of cooperation between their professors, faculty members, departments, or research institutes under the provisions of this memorandum. The two parties have agreed to the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), which comprises the following points and activities.

Article I

This MoU aims to strengthen the academic and educational links between the two parties to achieve mutually beneficial relationships under the provisions of the laws and regulations in both countries.

Article II

Both sides agree to mutually advance academic and educational cooperation in achieving the common goals that contribute to the development of inclusive curriculum design, academic staff development and program delivery and continuous improvement, including:

- Exchange of guest lecturer visits to undertake hybrid teaching.
- Development of joint courses and education programs.
- 3. Exchange of professors and researchers for research, lecturers, or conferences.
- Development of research collaborations and disseminations that national or international research grants may fund.

5. Exchange of information, including the development of learning and teaching materials, artifacts, and research publications.

6. Development of inclusive curriculum design, academic staff development and program delivery and continuous improvement.

Article III

Negotiation and agreement regarding the implementation or inclusion of specific activities based on this MoU will be undertaken independently between the faculties and specialized departments that carry out those activities. This MoU is subject to the statutes, laws, and regulations observed in each country.

Article IV

This MoU may be modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both sides.

Article V

This MoU is valid from the date both sides approve it. It may be renewed after both sides review and agree on any modifications to its articles.
